Creation of this section opened new possibilities for Clinical pharmacy, mainly in further education of pharmacists and doctors. It created the best environment for academic discussion. Based on this the symposia of clinical pharmacy were organised. The last one in April 2011 (28.4.2011 – 29.4.2011) marked the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary Symposium of Clinical Pharmacy. Its main topic was Pharmacotherapy in Paediatrics and for the first time Lívia Magulová was missing. However she managed to be there and not because it was organised by the Department of Clinical Pharmacology in Nitra Teaching Hospital, where she was working, but thanks to the discussion and presence of people from different fields. A new tradition started – the symposium will be named after Lívia Magulová.

To support the idea of discussion and presentation several presenters were asked to elaborate on their topics and to publish them in this specially oriented supplement. Symbolically in a day and in a year you can read this issue which was brought forth at the XX Symposium of Clinical Pharmacy dedicated to Lívia Magulová.

All of us, lucky enough to work with her, miss and remember her as an enthusiastic, hard-working and encouraging clinical pharmacist, who earned respect.
