Prof. Dr Dr h.c. mult Klaus Wegmann studied chemistry at the University of Karlsruhe and biology at the University of Tübingen. He held several positions in free enterprises before he was appointed professor of plant biology at the University of Tübingen in 1980. Professor Wegmann was an active member of CORESTA for many years. After his retirement, he became vice chancellor of the University of Arad in Romania, a position he was active in until shortly before his death. The editors and the staff of the Journal owe Professor Wegmann a debt of gratitude for the work he dedicated to the improvement of the quality of many manuscripts for this Journal.
