

EDITORIAL POLICY

The editorial policy of the journal *Economics and Culture* declares the principles of accepting, reviewing and publishing process. The editorial policy of the journal Economic and Culture is based on ethical values and principles in order to avoid any illegal practices, e.g. plagiarism, and to respect the intellectual ownership.

Journal editors take the responsibility for:

- providing guidelines to authors for preparing and submitting manuscripts;
- treating all authors with fairness, courtesy, objectivity, honesty, and transparency;
- protecting the confidentiality of every author's work;
- establishing a system for effective and rapid peer review;
- informing the authors about the editorial decision regarding the submitted papers rapidly;
- ensuring timely publication of accepted manuscripts

The journal *Economics and Culture* accepts articles, which were not published in any other journals/proceedings and have not been submitted for consideration to any other journals/proceedings.

Languages of publications is English. The main criteria for articles selection are originality, scientific and practical value, properly selected and applied research methods, validity of the results and conclusions.

The manuscripts have to be prepared according to requirements of the journal *Economics and Culture* (see *Guidelines for Authors* and *Paper template*). Manuscripts are considered on conformity to those requirements by the editors and can be returned to the author for changes. The editors may reject manuscripts without external peer review. Reasons for this can be that the manuscript is outside the scope of the journal, does not meet the journal's quality standards or lacks novel information. The authors will be informed about this via e-mail. In case of the positive pre-reviewing decision the submitted manuscripts are sent to two external referees with the proper expertise in the relevant field. Editors of the journal *Economics and Culture* assure the anonymity of reviewers and authors during the entire review process.
