ICAME is an international organization of linguists and information scientists working with English machine-readable texts. The aim of the organization is to collect and distribute information on English language material that is available for computer processing, and on linguistic research completed or in progress on this material, to compile an archive of English text corpora in machine-readable form, and to make material available to research institutions.

Uni Computing in Bergen, Norway, acts as a distribution centre for computerized English-language corpora and corpus-related software (for details, see p. 241 in this issue). Annual conferences have been arranged since 1979. The present issue of the *ICAME Journal* (previously *ICAME News*) is published by De Gruyter Open (DGO).
