

Notes for Authors

General information: Authors should not submit the same manuscript, in the same or different languages, in whole or in part, simultaneously to more than one journal. The Forest Research Papers CrossCheck uses anti-plagiarism system. Articles are printed in Polish and articles English are available in online version (PDF file).

Manuscripts in Polish or English should not exceed 22 pages of A4 size (including tables, figures, and reference list) of standard typescript (single column, 30 lines of text per page, 40.000 total characters including spaces) and should be written in English or in the Author's native language. Pages and text lines should be numbered. To a file in Word format, please attach a file the entire article in PDF format.

Papers should be submitted electronically through <http://www.editorialmanager.com/frp>

List of authors. During the peer review process the identity of the author article should be in order to conceal as a separate file:

- 1) all information regarding the article author, including the full name, address of the institution where the work was completed, corresponding author address, phone, e-mail address;
- 2) individual contribution of each author forming article as: concept, statistical analysis, literature review, write a paper, etc.) – ghostwriting and guest authorship;
- 3) information about sources of research funding.

Corresponding Author should approve the submitted copy for publication and send to the Publisher a **declaration on publication originality, on ethical experimentation and interpretation and conflict of interests**. At the same time send a signed license to publish form. All forms are available on website www.lesne-prace-badawcze.pl.

Authors of articles on animal research should include an attestation of Local Ethics.

The responsibility for placed above information lies on the side of the author submitting the manuscript for publication.

Title: The title should be short and concise, and words such as ‘study’, ‘work’, and ‘investigation’ should be avoided.

Abstract: The abstract should be in English (or Polish language), have no more than 300 words, depict the paper's structure and contain the aim, description of applied methods and used material, the main research results and conclusions (individual parts of abstract should be in paragraph form).

Key words: The paper should include key words or phrases counting in total no more than 10 words. The key words should not repeat the title of the paper.

Text: The main body of the article should follow the general rules of scientific writing and be adequately structured. The Introduction should define the scope of the work in relation to other relevant works done in the same field. Material and Methods content should allow the replication of observations / experiments. Results should be presented with clarity and

precision, followed by Discussion containing interpretation of obtained results. Finally the Conclusions sum up the work done and point out the main achievements.

Plants or animals must be identified with taxonomic and common names. Abbreviations might be used if necessary, however the full description should follow their first use. The use of International System of Units (SI) is accepted only.

References: Literature citations in the text should contain the name of the author and the year of publication (in parenthesis). In the case of more than two authors, only the first one should be named in the text, followed by the phrase 'et al.', e.g. Andreas et al. 2000; Gullege, Schimel 2000. At the end of the paper, under the 'References' heading all items mentioned in the text should be placed in alphabetical order under the first author's name, citing all authors, according to the ISO 690:2010 standard (The names and titles written in Cyrillic alphabet should be given in transliteration according to the ISO-9 standard. It is recommended to refer to the reviewed publications only. Journal titles should be given in full. The International Standard Book Number (ISBN) should be included for the cited books and DOI (digital object identifier) for journal articles.

Tables, figures and illustrations: Make figures and tables should be easily understandable without reference to the main body of the article. If a long explanation is required, it may be provided in a footnote rather than a headnote.

Tables, figures should be included in the main text. Figures should also be sent as separate, editable files. Photographs are allowed provided that they contribute essential information to the text. They should be submitted as separate good quality (300 dpi) JPEG or TIFF files.

Proofreading: Author's correction will be sent to the corresponding author's address.

Peer Review Policy. All articles are reviewed by two independent reviewers. The [list of reviewers](#) is published once a year. Whole procedure is described on www.lesne-prace-badawcze.pl/article-review-procedure.

The eligibility criteria. Only scientific articles (i.e., presenting the results of original research – empirical, theoretical, technical, or analytical, the current state of knowledge, research methodology, research process and its results and conclusions with examples cited literature as well as monographic or polemic papers and review) can be published. When peer review is finished the section editor in collaboration with the editor-in-chief qualifies or disqualifies papers for publishing.

Rejection Rate – ca 25%.

Articles are published under the Creative Commons BY-NC-ND (license model is available on the website: lesne-prace-badawcze.pl).

Publication fees: Color figures are paid (470 PLN per printing sheet) and Authors who cannot pay color charges must use black and white figures. There is also the opportunity to preserve the color in the electronic version of article without any additional fees. Invoice for printing color pages will be issued when the page numbering will be approved. Invoice details should be sent along with the article if accepted for publication.
