

Editorial policy

Authors are invited to submit manuscripts reporting recent developments in their field. The paper must be an original unpublished work written in English that is not currently under review by other journals. All papers should be submitted electronically only, via our website (<http://saeb.feaa.uaic.ro/>). **There are no submission or publication costs for authors.**

Manuscripts should follow the format style of the journal. The papers should not exceed 30 pages, including figures and references. Detailed background information on the submission of papers and reviews can be found in the *Submission section*.

As part of the submission process, authors are required to check off their submission's compliance with all of the following items, and submissions may be returned to authors that do not adhere to these guidelines:

1. The submission has not been previously published, nor is it before another journal for consideration (or an explanation has been provided in *Comments/Letter to the Editor*).
2. The paper is written only in English (either British English or American English spelling may be used, but should be followed consistently throughout the article). Please carefully check the spelling before uploading the manuscript.
3. All figures and tables are placed within the text at the appropriate points, rather than at the end.
4. Please upload only Microsoft Word .doc or .docx files.
5. Where available, URLs for the references and DOIs have been provided.
6. The originality, importance, clarity and author's contribution will be evaluated in a double blind review system. **Authors will upload two files:**

1. **The complete manuscript** (will not contain any information about the author/authors), using the stylistic and bibliographic requirements outlined in the [Template document](#). Please follow the instructions in [Ensuring a Blind Review](#) in order to insure the manuscript does not contain any personal information.

2. **The cover page:** will contain complete information about the author/authors (institutional affiliation, contact, etc.). See: [About the authors](#)

7. The editorial board is participating in a growing community of CrossCheck System's users in order to ensure that the content published is original and trustworthy.
