As per the journal value rating scale of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education (MNiSW), articles published in the journal are awarded 14 points. They are published online in Open Access format at <https://www.degruyter.com/view/j/mgrsd> and in hard copy, and listed in over 30 abstract databases, including SCOPUS, EBSCO, DOAJ and ERIH PLUS.

“Miscellanea Geographica” is an interdisciplinary journal for presenting research results in geography, regional and economic studies, and social, historical and political issues, relating to key problems in the broader area of development and to natural, social and economic conditions in various regions of the world. The scale of phenomena dealt with ranges from the local, through the regional, to even – in justifiable cases – the global.
