Submission of Manuscripts – Instructions for Authors

Submissions are subject to academic review

Submissions shall be written in good English
(American or British English is accepted,
but not a mixture of these).

Submissions can be made at any time via email:

The journal does not have article processing charges
(APCs) nor article submission charges.

Submissions must include:

1. Information about Author(s)
2. Title of the paper
3. Main text and footnotes
4. References
5. Abstract
6. Key-words
7. Appendices

ad. 1. Author's information

Submission must include Author's full name, details of scientific degrees, institutional affiliation, and contact information, including e-mail address.

Author is obliged to reveal all co-authors of the manuscript and participants in the project.

Information about Author should be placed on the first page, preferably in the upper left corner of the paper.

ad. 3. Main text

Text/paper/discussion/review:

- a) Length of the article: should not be less than half of the publisher's sheet and should not exceed one publisher's sheet, i.e. between 20 000 and 40 000 chars with spaces [approx. 10–15 pages], with tables and figures;
- b) Technical requirements:
 - file type: .doc or .docx,
 - A4 format with justified text,
 - *italics* and **bold** are allowed,
 - do not underline or **highlight**,
 - do not use header or footer,
 - do not number pages,
 - margin: 2,5 cm,
 - preferable font: Times New Roman – main text 12 (with 1,5 line spacing).
- c) It is strongly advisable to divide the paper into parts i.e.: the introduction, at least 3–4 main issues, and conclusions.

Footnotes:

- a) For secondary comments and remarks,
- b) Placed at the bottom of the page, numbered continuously,
- c) Technical requirements: preferable font: Times New Roman, 10 with 1,0 line spacing.

ad. 4. References

Use APA style for referencing and citation. For more information see: Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, 6th ed.

All quotes must be placed in inverted commas and have a source.

List of references:

- a) at the end of the manuscript, a list of references should be provided with all the sources referred to,
- b) entries should be alphabetized by the last name of the first author of each work,
- c) for multiple articles by the same author, or authors listed in the same order, list the entries in chronological order, from earliest to most recent,
- d) more than one reference from the same author(s) in the same year must be identified by the letters “a”, “b”, etc., placed after the year of publication,

- e) present the journal title in full,
- f) citing and listing of web references: as a minimum, the full URL should be given.

ad. 5. Abstract

Abstract should not exceed 500 chars with spaces.

ad. 6. Key-words

Key-words: 3 to 8 words or phrases divided by commas.

ad. 7. Appendices

Any maps, tables, pictures etc. data should be black and white only (we do not publish in colour) and should be submitted both within the paper and in additional files with description.
