

Editorial policy

The editorial board approves the scope and content of the current journal issue and can select a major topic for the issue. The editor pre-selects manuscripts that go through the review process. All scientific articles (original research papers and review papers) are double-blind peer-reviewed. The editorial board agrees on two reviewers per each pre-selected scientific articles (see research papers and review papers). The reviewers are neither members of the editorial board nor the employee of the same department as the author or one of the co-authors. The review process is anonymous. The reviewers do not know the names of authors and vice versa the authors are not informed about the reviewers.

Editor addresses the approved reviewers by e-mail. The addressed reviewers have 2 days to accept the offer. Otherwise another reviewer is appointed and contacted. The e-mail sent to a reviewer includes an article without details about the author(s), and the submission URL. The reviewer has 14 days to log into the journal web site and write the review. On the request of a reviewer the deadline may be extended (max 21 days in total). After receiving both of reviews for each scientific article the editor informs members of the editorial board about the outcome. Authors are also informed about the decision and receives a report statement. On the basis of reviews and the report statement, the editorial board decides the publication of the article. The report statement includes the statement of acceptance; section selection; reviewers' comments and conclusion (summary).

The report statement does not cover the names of the reviewers so that they remain anonymous. The report statement is sent to the author by email and he/she has 14 days to rewrite/incorporate the comments in the report to his/her article. If necessary, the limit may be extended to 21 days. If the author does not revise the article within the deadline, the publishing of the article is postponed to the next issue of the journal.

After submitting the revised article, precisely after incorporating the comments of reviewers, and delivering all attachments in the required form (pictures, photographs, tables, etc.), the article is checked by editor or one (or both) reviewer(s) and it is passed on to language correction. Consequently, it is submitted for printing, resp. again returned for completion.

Handing on the article authors agree with its publication in the journal and also declare that the article is an original paper and they have the copyright to it. Articles are not remunerated.
