

Editorial Review Policy

East-West Cultural Passage journal is committed to the publication of high quality works with significant contribution to the field. Decision about each manuscript is taken following a rigorous process:

Procedure

All scholarly manuscripts submitted for consideration for publication in *East-West Cultural Passage* journal are refereed. Initially, a designated member of the editorial board makes a preliminary assessment about the quality and suitability of a submission in terms of scope, originality and plagiarism. Once the designated internal editorial board member is satisfied about the suitability of a submission, it is sent to two anonymous peer reviewers for their comment. The review process is blind. Manuscripts are sent out to two subject specialists for reviewing anonymously. The review process usually takes between 45-60 days. The referees' comments are forwarded to authors in view of appropriate revision. The referees' comments on rejected manuscripts shall be forwarded to authors upon request. The journal reserves the right not to include revised articles that do not fully respond to the alterations suggested by the reviewer. The final decision regarding publication rests with the Editor-in-Chief. An accepted manuscript will subsequently be forwarded to the Manuscript Editor for final processing.
