General information: “Die Bodenkultur: Journal for Land Management, Food and Environment” is a scientific journal published quarterly by the "Universität für Bodenkultur, Wien (BOKU)" (University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences, Vienna) and the "Österreichische Agentur für Gesundheit und Ernährungssicherheit (AGES)" (Austrian Agency for Health and Food Safety). Papers are published mainly in English but also in German (with titles and abstracts in the respective other language as well).

Aims & scopes: “Die Bodenkultur: Journal for Land Management, Food and Environment” is an interdisciplinary forum dedicated to all aspects of research in the rural area. Our aim is to provide an international outlet for new results in all disciplines of land management, food, environment and related sciences, both at the national and the international level. The journal:

- keeps its readers up-to-date with the latest scientific research results,
- provides an interdisciplinary perspective on current developments in rural areas,
- only publishes original research work subject to anonymous review by two referees,
- publishes accepted manuscripts promptly.
