*Disputatio* is an international journal of philosophy in the analytic tradition. It is currently owned by the Centre of Philosophy of the University of Lisbon and managed by the LanCog research group. It is sponsored by Fundação para a Ciência e Tecnologia – Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology (UIDP/00310/2020). The journal is a non-profit publishing venture. It is currently published by De Gruyter/Sciencdo, exclusively online, as a fully Open-Access journal.

*Disputatio* is one of the leading philosophy journal in the Portuguese-speaking world. It has been classified in category Q2 of the SCImago Journal Rank in 2015, 2016, 2018 and 2019, and in category A2 of Qualis. It was also classified in category INT2 (previously B) of the 2011 ERIH ranking of the European Science Foundation and in category B in the 2010 Australian Association of Philosophy and the Australian Research Council ranking.

- ▶ *Disputatio* aims at publishing high-quality articles in any area of analytic philosophy (broadly construed), written in either English or Portuguese.
- ▶ A submission for publication in *Disputatio* should make at least one original (possibly negative) point with sufficient plausibility and rigour.
- ▶ *Disputatio* practises triple-blind refereeing: the identity of the authors is revealed neither to the editors nor to the referees, and the identity of the referees is not revealed to the authors.
- ▶ On average, the reviewing process takes around four months.

## Benefits of publishing in *Disputatio*:

- ▶ Constructive and fair peer review by international experts in the field,
- ▶ High-quality editing,
- ▶ Articles abstracted by online indexing services and databases,
- ▶ Efficient route to fast-track publication and full advantage of DeGruyter's publishing platform,
- ▶ High international visibility of published articles due to Open Access.
