



Editorial Policy

PURPOSE

The Hungarian Studies Yearbook provides an English-language forum for high-quality peer-reviewed research in Hungarian language, literature, and culture (including ethnography, ethnology, interdisciplinary cultural studies, translation studies, theatre and film studies etc.). It is published one time per year, every October.

AUTHORSHIP

An author is an individual who has significantly contributed to the development of a manuscript.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT

Individuals who participated in the development of a manuscript but do not qualify as an author should be acknowledged. Organizations that provided support in terms of funding and/or other resources should also be acknowledged.

SUBMISSION OF MANUSCRIPT

Authors should read the “Instruction for Authors” on the site of the Yearbook before submitting a manuscript. Manuscripts should be prepared according to the style and specifications of the journal’s policy (i.e. the latest MLA Formatting and Style Guide)

By submitting a manuscript, the author(s) warrant that the manuscript is their own original work and that it has neither been published previously nor is currently being considered for publication elsewhere. They also warrant that the sources of any ideas and/or words in the manuscript that are not their own have been properly attributed through appropriate citations and/or quotes.

Manuscripts are accepted with the understanding that the authors have not violated any ethical practice followed in manuscripts in humanities and social sciences.

Once a manuscript is submitted, it is therefore assumed that all authors have read and given their approval for the submission of the manuscript.

The author(s) of a manuscript agree that if the manuscript is accepted for publication in the Hungarian Studies Yearbook, the published article will be copyrighted according to Gold Open Access model. The HSY will make all articles available for free on the journal's website. All articles will be available for sharing and reuse in open repositories via creative commons licence **CC BY-NC-ND**.

Submissions **must** be received by the editors on or before the deadlines specified. Copy for all articles **must** be supplied electronically via e-mail as attached documents. Authors will proofread their own manuscript.

PUBLISHING POLICY

Our publishing policy includes blind peer-review to filter the scientifically acceptable papers and improve the quality of the manuscripts.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF REVIEWERS

The Yearbook's reviewers perform work on a volunteer basis. Reviewers are free to decline invitations to review particular manuscripts at their discretion. They should also not accept manuscript review assignments for which they feel unqualified.

Reviewers who have accepted manuscript assignments are generally expected to submit their reviews within six weeks.

The editors decide whether the manuscript should be published. The editors reserve the right to edit or correct the articles (in terms of style, syntax, grammar, etc.), without altering the original sense and after obtaining the consent of the author(s). The editors reserve the right to ask the authors for content or format changes.

The editors will assure the anonymity of the peer-reviewers unless both parties – the author/s and the reviewers – agree to an open system.

PROCEDURES FOR DEALING WITH MALPRACTICE
