



## Hungarian Studies Yearbook

### Instructions for Authors

#### 1. Generalities

By submitting a manuscript, the author(s) warrant that the manuscript is their own original work and that it has neither been published previously nor is currently being considered for publication elsewhere. They also warrant that the sources of any ideas and/or words in the manuscript that are not their own have been properly attributed through appropriate citations and/or quotes.

Manuscript length can vary between 8 and 20 pages using proportional fonts and pages as described later. #### 2. Titles section

THE TITLE OF YOUR PAPER  
The subtitle of your paper (if there is one)

The e-mail address of the corresponding author

#### 3. Font size, line spacing, alignment,

12 pt Times New Roman should be chosen for the main text. Line spacing should be set at 1.5. The notes are to be set in 10 pt Times New Roman. The main text should be fully justified (align left + right).

4. Abstract and keywords

A short abstract of max. 150 words should accompany your manuscript, and it should be placed under the titles section. Also, 4-8 keywords should be provided that describe the core idea and narrow field of your research.

5. Citations

HSY uses short in-text references / parenthetical notes whenever a bibliography is cited in order to keep the reader's focus on the main text. Footnotes provide supplementary comments or citations. Both types of notes are used according to the MLA Stylesheet.

6. Spelling

We accept both British English and American English spelling as it is consistent. If you are not a native speaker of English, we strongly advise you to have your paper proofread before submitting it to HSY.

7. Translation

Translation should be provided for Hungarian (and other non-English) material quoted throughout the manuscript.

8. Final works-cited list

The final works-cited list should be organized according to the MLA Style Sheet.
