ICAME Corpus Collection

Most of this collection was made in the period of 1977–1999. The total number of words for all 20 corpora amounts to 17 million (7.9 million words of written modern text, 2.5 million of transcribed speech and 6.6 million of historical text). 5.5 million words have been tagged for part of speech. The modern texts are from the 1960's onwards.

Most of this collection is now being made available through the CLARIN infrastructure (icame.uib.no/clarin/) with the Corpuscle system (clarino.uib.no/corpuscle). Corpuscle is a web-based corpus management and analysis platform developed at Uni Research, now NORCE, Bergen. Academic users are able to search, analyse and download various ICAME corpora in Corpuscle: please see the instructions at <http://clu.uni.no/icame/clarin/login.html> for how to access the resources.
