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The Journal of Critical Care Medicine aims to publish high quality double-blind peer-reviewed articles integrating a broad range of topics from the entire spectrum of critical care medicine and related pathologies of critical care patients (cardiology, surgery, internal medicine, pneumology, infectious diseases, organ transplantation, emergency medicine, neurology, anaesthesiology, etc).

The journal will consider for publication suitable articles offering new insights into pathophysiological mechanisms, diagnostic and treatment in critical care medicine, from basic to clinical academic research, including also relevant topics on biomedical research, health policy research, medical technology development and ethical concerns.

JOURNAL SCOPE

The journal addresses the entire community of specialists involved in treating the critically ill patients, with a special focus on the scientific community from Central and Eastern European countries, aiming to provide studies on critical care medicine with a new regional perspective, specific for this part of Europe but not restricted to it.
