

## **GUIDELINES FOR REVIEWERS**

The journal use a closed single-blind peer review system (the names of the reviewers are hidden from the authors). Submitted manuscripts are reviewed by two experts. Reviewers are asked to recommend whether a manuscript should be accepted, revised or rejected.

Reviewers are asked to provide detailed, constructive comments that will help both the editors make a decision on the publication and the author(s) to improve their manuscript. They should point out whether the work has serious flaws that preclude its publication, or whether additional experiments should be carried out or additional data should be collected to support the conclusions drawn.

When preparing the reports, we ask our reviewers to fill the Review Form in the separate file. Please return completed the form and manuscript with your corrections within two weeks to the Editorial Office or inform the Editor as soon as possible, if you are not able to do so. You can submit your review via email to the Editorial Office.
