Statement of informed consent

All papers submitted to Romanian Journal of Orthopaedic Surgery and Traumatology should declare agreement with the following "statement of informed consent". No paper lacking it will be considered for publication.

Patients have a right to privacy that should not be infringed without informed consent. All information which could contribute to identify patients, including patients' names, initials or hospital numbers should not be published in written descriptions, photographs etc., unless the information is essential for scientific purposes and the patient (or parent or guardian) gives explicit written informed consent for publication. The manuscript should be shown to the patient before publication and specific and explicit informed consent should be obtained.

Identifying details should be omitted if they are not essential. However, since complete anonymity is difficult to achieve, informed consent should be obtained from each patient involved, if there is any doubt.
